ork on the OAA-Tullow Science Block is proceeding steadily and the contractor plans to hand over the building to us on 24th February 2020. Akora Ian Quartey, our Project Consultant, visited the site and shared with me the pictures below. The supplier of science equipment has also begun work in Kumasi. He expects to finish on time. We have ordered 4 SmartBoards to be installed in the 4 labs, and will begin the training of teachers after the holidays. We will soon place the order for various chemicals and other consumables for use in the labs. In sum, we are 'good to go'. As soon as we receive the various amounts pledged by individuals and year groups we will suspend fundraising.

On the land front, we are working with the School Board to put in place structures for managing the lands. We are also supporting the School to pursue all the known litigation cases in court. There are no new ones.

The OAA is assisting Achimota School with preparation for the next competition of the National Science and Mathematics Quiz. We have put in place a team chaired by Professor Ivan Addae-Mensah, and with some great young scientists, to provide technical support. There are also incentives for both staff and students who are involved. We are doing all we can to assist the School to regain the trophy last won in 2004.

I would like to assure you that Achimota School and OAA are in a relatively good place. These days, many more people make the effort to pay their dues. This is very commendable and I would like to thank all those who make the effort to pay dues and other levies. In the coming year, may it be our resolution as true Akoras to meet our obligations to OAA.
