- BRIEFING OF OAA REPS ON CENTENARY PLANNING ACTIVITIES March 14, 2026 @2pm in Achimota School

Sincere thanks to all who joined the briefing on the Centenary Planning activities.

Key Highlights of the meeting:

1. Presentation on the Centenary Preparations and Planned Activities.

2. Financing the Celebrations:

There was the agreed need to support Achimota@100 along 2 pillars:

- Centenary Celebrations (The Now)
- Endowment for Achimota School through the ASET Fund (The Future).

After intense deliberations the meeting agreed as follows:

Each Year Group will be levied a fixed amount. The "active" Year Groups - in the 10 to 50 years of leaving Achimota range - will be levied **GHS500,000**. Much older and younger Year Groups will be levied less - **GHS250,000 per Year Group** – or as they are able (more detailed information on this will be shared separately).

Details on the payment structure will be shared by **March 31, 2026**.

The **Centenary Legacy Project of the OAA** is a **new Achimota School Clinic** to serve as a first point-of-call for the now over 4,800 student population. The clinic design was presented. This project is separate from the Centenary Year Group contributions and will target Corporate Bodies, Individual Akoras and Friends of Achimota for support for this all-important project. All donors for this project will be specifically recognized on plaques on the Clinic building.


3. Committees and Involvement Opportunities:
